The children will be served toast or bagel, cereal, fruit juice and water.

## Admission procedures and bookings

Toast club is a drop-in session run daily from 8am for children from Foundation 2 (reception class) upwards. If you wish your child to attend the club you will need to complete a registration form via the link for which is available on the school website>Toast & After School Club.

## Fees and billing

Current fees for the Toast Club are £4.00 from 7:30am and £3.00 from 8am (subject to notified change) per child per session and must be paid via ParentPay. Any arrears of five days or more will be reviewed by school and may result in your child being prevented from taking up a place in the Toast Club.

## Age range of eligible children

Children aged 3 to 11 years who attend Sacred Heart Primary School, are welcome to attend our toast club. We are unable to take nursery aged children at present.

## Management of the club

The club is run and managed by Sacred Heart Catholic Primary School. The line manager for staff is Mrs Bennett.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### How long will breakfast be served for?

Breakfast will be served until 8:20am to allow the children time to finish eating before going in to class.

### Is the Toast Club able to cater for specific dietary needs?
