Year 2 enjoyed outdoor learning this week becoming scientists looking at micro-habitats in the school grounds.



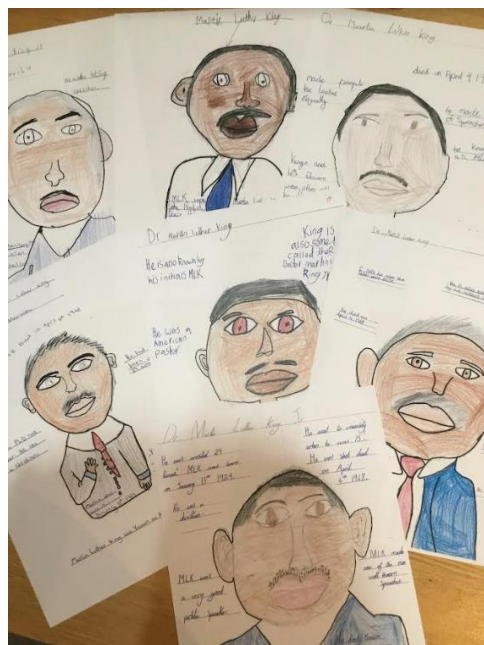
Year 3

Year 4

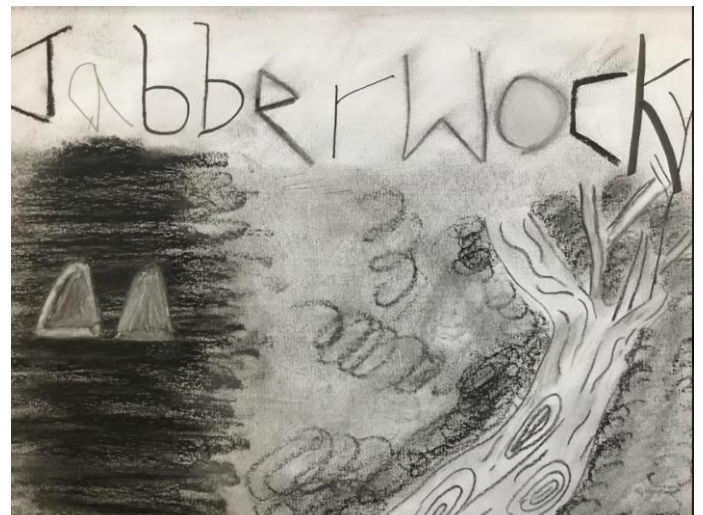

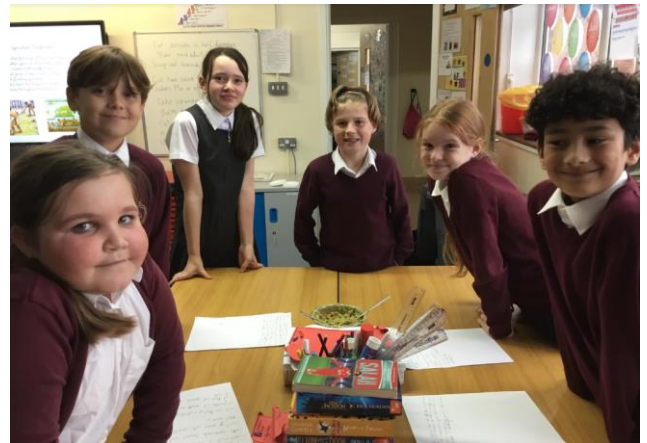
Year 5
