## Music



Children will learn the names of the notes when playing the glockenspiel. They will experiment with changing the beat when the tempo changes and know that tempo means fast and slow. The children will develop their performance skills by working in groups.

## Computing



Online Safety: The children will learn about the importance of staying safe online.

Control and Programming: Program a bot or sprite by giving simple sequences to create loops.

## Art and Design



### Making Birds

The children will begin to understand the relationship between drawing and making, 2d and 3d shapes and objects. They will explore how to transform materials into sculpture, by manipulating paper, and move from mark making to balance and structure. The children will design, create and evaluate their own bird.

## Science

### Plants & Seasonal Changes



The children will learn about how plants have specific names and that plants have common parts. They will learn key characteristics of plants and be able to identify them. Children will be able to spot signs of Summer and will understand the differences between each season.

## Geography

### Marvellous Maps



The children will know the surrounding seas of the United Kingdom. They will learn how to use simple locational and directional language (near and far, left and right) to describe the location of features on a map. They will also know that when we look at something from above, it is called an aerial view. Children will learn how to devise their own simple map.

## R.E.

### The Resurrection



The children will know that we celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus at Easter. They will know that Jesus rose from the dead on the first Easter Sunday and what that means for us. The children will hear how Jesus appeared to the disciples and how he helped them to understand that he was alive. They will also find out that Thomas did not believe that Jesus was alive and that Jesus returned to heaven after forty days making a promise to send the Holy Spirit.
