### Writing



Using our text, the children will develop their writing skills using word families based on common words showing how words are related in form and meaning, before writing a story with a 'Egyptian Mystery Narrative and a Secret Diary'. The children will develop their use of headings and subheadings to aid their presentation.

### Guided Reading

The children will be recapping a variety of key reading skills looking at author's choice of vocabulary, retrieving key information and inferring information. The children will make predictions based on what they've read.

## Music



Children will learn about how music can bring us together. They will appraise different songs and develop their knowledge of key musical features.

## Art and Design

In art, the children will be looking at making animations by creating drawings that move in a sequence. They will make their own moveable drawings, using their imagination to think about what character they want to make and how they might make it move.

## Geography

The children will learn to use the 8 points of the compass, use directional language within the school grounds. They will learn the importance of reading maps and will examine grid references.

## Science

### Plants

The children will identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants: roots, stem/trunk, leaves and flowers. They will explore the requirements of plants for life and growth (air, light, water, nutrients from soil, and room to grow) and how they vary from plant to plant. They will also learn the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.
